## SCHOOL DESCRIPTION

Parkview Baptist School is an independent, co-educational school with approximately 1,270 students in pre-k through 12<sup>th</sup> grades and offers a quality college-preparatory, Christ-centered education. Parkview Baptist School is a ministry of Parkview Baptist Church and is approved by the Louisiana Department of Education and is accredited by the Southern Association of Independent Schools and Advanc-Ed (formerly SACS - Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.) Approximately ninety-six percent of Parkview's graduates go on to post-secondary education each year.

## CURRICULUM AND ACADEMICS

Parkview Baptist School has a challenging curriculum developed to recognize the diversity of learning styles, education levels, and personal interests of our students. Our fine arts program facilitates the development of students artistic, musical and performance talents through Visual Arts, Choral, Instrumental, Speech and Theater courses. Advanced Placement courses are currently offered in English Language, English Literature, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, US History, European History, US Government, Calculus AB, and Studio Art. Honors courses are offered in English, Math, Science, History and Foreign Language. Parkview Baptist School is consistently represented by students recognized through the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.
