## Homecoming Parade Participation Rules for Float Entry

- 1. Organization must be an established class or club at the high school.
- 2. Each organization must have a representative or contact person.
- 3. Each person riding on the float or walking in the parade MUST have a signed permission slip to participate. (Signed slips are due by Thursday, October 18)
- 4. The organization representative or class president is responsible for distributing and collecting all signed permission slips.
- 5. All vehicles MUST be driven by an adult with a valid Louisiana driver's license. Each entry must also have an adult sponsor supervising the float/vehicle/walkers always.
- 6. Students must not dangle feet from the float/trailer/truck or car in the parade. Participants must remain inside the vehicle.
- 7. Float must be on a truck bed or trailer and may NOT be a convertible. **ONLY HOMECOMING COURT WILL RIDE IN CONVERTIBLES. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- 8. All floats of any kind, including walkers, must be registered through the application process with the student council and must be approved by Mrs. Madden.
- 9. The application deadline for all Homecoming Parade participant applications is THURSDAY. OCTOBER 18. No late registration!
- 10. All SIGNED permission slips are due to your class president by Thursday, October 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 11. All entries must be approved by Mrs. Madden and Mr. Mitchell.
- 12. All floats/walkers will be lined up in the order dictated by the Parade committee.
- 13. NO REFERENCES TO MARDI GRAS MAY BE MADE EITHER IN DRESS OR DECORATIONS ON THE FLOATS OR BY WALKERS. MARDI GRAS SPECIFIC BEADS WILL NOT BE THROWN, AND TRADITIONAL MARDI GRAS COLORS SHOULD BE AVOIDED.
- 14. NO CANDY MAY BE THROWN.
- 15. Judgment of the appropriateness of all float entries and walkers will be left to the discretion of the Homecoming Parade Committee and Mrs. Madden
- 16. All floats/vehicles/walkers must arrive in the Laser Tag / OLOL parking lot by 10:30 A.M. for lineup. **No earlier than 9:30 a.m.**
- 17. No Parking will be allowed other than approved floats in the OLOL / Laser Tag lots
- 18. Your entry does not have to be a float. A decorated vehicle, golf cart or walking group qualifies as an entry. However, all entries must adhere to the rules listed above.
