CLINIC INFORMATION

Times and Dates -April 6th and 7th, 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the PBS High School Gym.

- 1. Everyone trying out for Silver Steppers <u>MUST</u> attend the two-day clinic. April 6th will be technique tryouts and learn a dance. April 7th will be dance tryout.
- 2. Everyone trying out must be enrolled or re-enrolled to PBS prior to tryouts. This will be checked.
- 3. The Information sheet, \$50.00, a copy of the insurance card, the permission form, concussion form, teacher recommendations from the student's English, Math, and Bible teachers and the signed rules and guidelines must be turned in before the first day of the clinic. Make checks payable to PBS.
- 4. The clinic and tryouts are closed to all friends and family members. We feel this is in the best interest of each participant.
- 5. Technique tryouts will be held on April 6th during the clinic.
- 6. **Seniors** who have been on the squad for three consecutive years, **in good standing**, will not tryout, but still participate in the clinic.

TRYOUTS

Time and Date -April 6-7th, 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. in the PBS High School Gym.

- 1. Participants must wear appropriate dance attire with no logos or school names.
- 2. After tryouts, participants will be dismissed. The 2020-2021 PBS Silver Stepper Team will be emailed to all those trying out.
- 3. All tryouts are closed to everyone except coaches, sponsors, and judges.
- 4. Anyone trying out must be officially enrolled and have paid all fees for the 2020-2021 PBS school year.
- 5. Upon making the squad, each member will be assessed \$600 on their FACTS account. This money will be applied to deposits for camp, uniforms, etc.
- 6. All balances for tryouts/uniforms, etc. must be paid in full by the last day of school in May.

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RULES & GUIDELINES 2020-2021

A Parkview Baptist Silver Stepper has a tremendous responsibility to the school and community. It is imperative she is a committed, self-disciplined young lady who has a passion and love for dancing and competition. This sport requires hard work on a day to day basis and a commitment to the squad as a team.

The following rules and guidelines are necessary to reach our goals for 2020-2021.

- Practice for the school year of 2020-2021 will begin on Tuesday, April 21, 2020. Practice will be from 3:00 -5:30 p.m. every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Last day of practice will be Thursday, May 7th. Dance camp is July 23 - 26, 2020.
- 2. **Nationals will be February 20, 2021.** We will practice on Fridays and Saturdays if needed in January and February. Information about nationals will come at a later date.
- 3. **Band camp** is set for July 27- August 4, 2020 at PBS, 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. each day. Band camp will also have practice August 6th from 4:00-9:00 pm at PBS. All Silver Steppers are expected to participate in all Band Festivals/Competitions. Parent show-off will be at PBS on August 6, time to be announced.
- 4. **Following tryouts, the new squad will begin Tuesday,** April 21, 2020. We will have a Varsity and Toptoe fitting on Thursday, April 9th in the Early Childhood Resource from 8:00 a.m. to immediately after school. All uniform items will be billed to your FACTS account. We will also attend a private dance camp for our team only at PBS. All participants are expected to be in attendance from the beginning of camp on July 23 to the end of camp on July 26. This camp is mandatory as it brings the squad together as a group.
- 5. All Silver Steppers and parents are expected to participate in each and every fundraiser. Our mini dance camp is set for June 1-4. All Steppers are expected to work each day from 8:30 a.m. noon. Parent help will be needed each day also. Each family is responsible for selling \$800 in ads for the football program which generates a large amount of money for our organization to be used throughout the year. Anything less than \$800 will be billed to your FACTS account.
- 6. All Silver Steppers are <u>expected to attend every practice</u> with the exception of a family emergency or illness. In these cases, the <u>sponsor/coach must be personally contacted</u>. A missed practice due to illness requires a doctor's excuse.
- 7. All squad members must be in attendance at school <u>for the first four classes of a school day</u> of a performance or practice in order to participate. Missed practices will result in missed performances.
- 8. Uniforms and hair will be worn in a neat and clean fashion. Uniforms are not to be worn at any time without the permission of the sponsor or coach.
- 9. All Silver Steppers are expected to maintain at all times the high standard of behavior and conduct becoming of a Christian young lady. This includes the refusal to use drugs, alcohol or tobacco, the use of foul language, and disrespect for fellow students and authority. The consequences may result in suspension or dismissal from the squad. As Silver Steppers, you represent the school and are more visible than any other organization.

All Silver Steppers will refrain from abusing any social networking site, such as Facebook, Myspace, Twitter, Instagram, Tictoc, Snapchat, etc., and posting anything that would be constrained as inappropriate or defame Parkview Baptist School or the squad in any way, shape or form. If such a thing occurs, then there will be serious consequences. Cell phone texting applies to this as well.

- **10.** Late arrival or absences for practices or performances will be addressed on an individual basis with the coach. We are a team and each member is always expected to present and on time at each practice or performance.
- 11. Each Silver Stepper must maintain a cumulative grade point average of <u>2.0</u> for each grading period. If in any grading period she falls below that average, it will result in academic probation. A member will be able to participate during this probationary period. At the end of the next grading period, if the average is brought up, she will no longer be on probation. However, if the grade point average continues to remain below a 2.0, the member will be academically ineligible and unable to perform with the squad until the next grading period.
- 12. Any negative attitude or behavior by a squad member will be immediately addressed by the sponsor or coach. The sponsor or coach has the authority at any time to have a squad member sit out for behavior unacceptable or damaging to the Silver Stepper squad. This includes bullying of anyone, or even another member of the squad.
- **13.** Each member is required to participate in all activities including pep rallies, football games, volleyball games, basketball games, fundraisers, etc. <u>If for some reason someone needs to miss any activities, she will need to have it approved by the sponsor or coach prior to being excused.</u>
- 14. All fees must be paid and you must be enrolled for the 2020-2021 school year prior to trying out.
- 15. **Senior girls who have been on the team for three consecutive years**, (ninth, tenth, and eleventh grade), and also in **good standing**, will be excused from tryouts. These girls will have automatic placement on the team.

IN ORDER FOR OUR SQUAD TO BE SUCCESSFUL, WE MUST ADHERE TO THESE GUIDELINES AND MAINTAIN DISCIPLINE. IT IS THE DESIRE OF PARKVIEW BAPTIST SCHOOL THAT THESE RULES SERVE AS REMINDERS TO MAINTAIN ORDER AND HAVE A SUCCESSFUL SILVER STEPPER SQUAD.
