# PBS Junior Beta Club Service Hours Guidelines

The date for service hours begins the first day of school and must be completed by the last day of school. If you are attending convention, hours must be completed two weeks prior to BETA convention. These service hours must be separate from those required for middle school Bible. Please submit all completed forms to your Jr. Beta sponsor, Mrs. Liner, in the library.

## 5 service hours required per school year

#### <u>Acceptable</u>

- 1. Mission Trip (up to 5 hours allowed towards Beta)
- 2. Participating in Beta Convention (1 or 2 hours)
  - One hour if you are competing in a BETA competition at district or state convention
  - Two hours if you qualify to move on to compete at the state/national convention
- 3. Supporting PBS fundraisers and mission drives (packing materials for mission trips = 1 hr.)
- 4. Yard work, cleaning, etc. away from a student's residence without pay
- 5. Volunteer at church festivals
- 6. Assisting a PBS teacher or staff member
- 7. Church-organized service activity
- 8. Serving as support at charity walks/runs (walking/running does not qualify)
- 9. Volunteering with Animal Welfare Organizations
- 10. Emergency Response Preparedness/Clean-up
- 11. Health & Wellness Fair Volunteer
- 12. Feeding the homeless or collecting/preparing supply packs
- 13. Volunteering with Military/Veteran Organizations
- 14. School Beautification Projects

### **Unacceptable**

- 1. Incomplete service slip
- 2. Any paid activity
- 3. Working an event for a PBS club or team of which you are a member
- 4. Babysitting
