OUT OF SCHOOL GUESTS

1. Students grades 9th-12th may bring a guest from another high school and turn this form into the office by **Thurs, Oct. 20th**.
2. The Honor Code is in effect at all times. Students are expected to comply with the Honor Code at all times, because character does not change whether a student is at school or away from school.
3. All School Rules are in effect at all times. The under-age possession and use of tobacco, alcohol, or other illegal or dangerous drugs are prohibited under the laws of the state of Louisiana. Consistent with these laws, Parkview Baptist School prohibits the use of any of these substances in any form by its students, including their guests. Parkview Baptist School reserves the right to use alcohol detectors on PBS students and their guests at all dances.
4. Expelled or suspended students may not attend school dances.
5. Guests must adhere to the dress code of PBS including grooming and piercings.
6. The PBS student and their guest must enter and leave the dance together. The PBS student is responsible for the behavior of his/her guest and is subject to disciplinary action for failure to abide by the rules and regulations.
7. Parents will be contacted to pick up their child due to misbehavior at the dance.
8. The guest must bring a photo ID to be admitted to the dance.
9. PBS juniors and seniors may bring a PBS alum (under 21 years of age). A photo ID must be attached to the "Dance Guest Registration Form". Junior and seniors may also bring a current high school student from another school.
10. **Seniors Only:** Non-Parkview graduate guests must be under 21 years of age and attach a photo ID to the Dance Guest Registration Form.
11. The PBS Dance Guest Registration Form is valid for one dance only.
