DRESS CODE

GIRLS

- Dresses are to be formal dresses at least below the knee in length
- No low-cut dresses (front and back of dress) – no visible cleavage
- Two-piece dresses not allowed, unless the exposed area is covered
- Back of dress must be above the bra line – middle of back
- Appropriate neckline
- No exposed midriffs or front/side cutouts, which includes 2-piece outfits exposing midriffs
- Slit in dress must be no higher than knee high (may not be pinned)
- Dresses may not be see-through or “illusion” type fabric
- No visible undergarments
- No tight fitting or form-fitted dresses – should be loosely form-fitted, not hugging figure
- **Any questions about an acceptable dress, please email a picture to Mrs. Madden for approval (front and back).**

BOYS

- Dress for formal occasion (tuxedo or dress pants, shirt and tie, and jacket)
- Pants should fit appropriately and not hang below the waistline
- Shirts must remain on, buttoned, and tucked in
- Boys should be well-groomed, hair length should be appropriate



OUT OF SCHOOL GUESTS

1. The Dance Guest Registration Form must be completed and submitted to the Dean of Students by **Wednesday, March 29th!**
2. The Honor Code is always in effect. Students are always expected to comply with the Honor Code, because character does not change whether a student is at school or away from school.
3. PBS juniors and seniors may bring a PBS or non-Parkview freshman / sophomore as a guest.
4. PBS juniors and seniors may bring a PBS alum (under 21 years of age). A photo ID must be attached to the “Dance Guest Registration Form”.
5. Juniors and Seniors may bring a non-Parkview graduate guest (must be under 21 years of age) and attach a photo ID to the Dance Guest Registration Form.
6. The PBS student and their guest must enter and leave the dance together. The PBS student is responsible for the behavior of his/her guest and is subject to disciplinary action for failure to abide by the rules and regulations.
7. As a ministry of Parkview Baptist Church and to align with the PBS Mission Statement, we must maintain a guest policy of male / female couples only.
8. All School Rules are always in effect. The under-age possession and use of tobacco, alcohol, or other illegal or dangerous drugs are prohibited under the laws of the state of Louisiana. Consistent with these laws, Parkview Baptist School prohibits the use of any of these substances in any form by its students, including their guests. Parkview Baptist School reserves the right to use alcohol detectors on PBS students and their guests at all dances.
9. Expelled or suspended students may not attend school dances.
10. Guests must adhere to the dress code of PBS. Males must be well-groomed.
11. Parents will be contacted to pick up their child due to misbehavior at the dance.
12. The PBS Dance Guest Registration Form is valid for one dance only.

DANCING

1. No suggestive dancing. Any behavior considered to be inappropriate by the Administration will be given one warning to stop the inappropriate behavior.
2. Students that have been warned will be asked to leave the dance upon contacting their parents if a second offense occurs.

OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS

1. Online dance registration is due with payment by **Friday, March 3rd!** We will not accept late registration! **No refunds!**
2. This dance is reserved for student's grades 11-12. Junior's and Senior's may bring a PBS student (or non-Parkview student) in 9th or 10th grade. No student below 9th grade will be permitted to attend.
3. Prom is from 8:00 p.m.-11:00 p.m.
4. No one will be admitted after 8:30 p.m. without a parent.
5. No one will be allowed to leave before 11:00 p.m.
6. No drinking of alcoholic beverages will be permitted before, during or after the dance. If a student is suspected or caught, his/her parents will be contacted to drive the student(s) home from the dance immediately. Parkview Baptist School reserves the right to use alcohol detectors on PBS students at all dances.
7. Students that are not dressed according to the guidelines will not be allowed to enter the dance. Parents will be contacted, and student will not be allowed to enter.
