1. Full annotation of book by either writing in notes on the margin or using sticky notes attached to each page. Each page should be fully annotated. You **must be able** to prove you read the book.
2. Look 4- **characterization, figurative language, imagery, story elements such as conflict(s), climax, resolution, and text that contributes to theme(s) within the text.** The book with thorough annotation is to be submitted to the teacher by the first week of the fall semester.
