



Early Childhood Supply Lists

To help us get the school year off to a smooth start, we ask families to provide a few basic supplies for their child's classroom. Supply items may be dropped off during Open House or Meet the Teacher so that your child's first day of school is as easy and stress-free as possible.

If your child wears diapers or pull-ups, families are responsible for maintaining an adequate supply. Teachers will notify you when supplies are running low.

Throughout the year, teachers may occasionally request additional supplies as classroom needs arise, but PBS will continue to provide the majority of your child's daily classroom materials.

General Supplies for All Students

1. One 4x6 or 5x7 family picture for classroom display (Please note: this picture will not be returned.)
2. Complete change of clothes in a labeled gallon size Ziploc bag. (This includes: Shirt, Underwear, Pants/shorts, Socks, Shoes) Please note: children who are potty training should bring multiple changes of clothes.

Nap Time Information

PBS will provide all nap time materials for students in the Toddlers through PK4 programs. Parents do not need to send any nap mats, blankets, or rest time items.

Wipes Policy

Infants, Toddlers, and Twos:

Please send 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes each month

PK3 and PK4:

Please send 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes in August and again in January.

Infant Supply List

Please clearly label **EVERYTHING** (Including bottle tops) with your child's name. We recommend name labels, not permanent marker or tape.

- Pacifier (if needed) This will be left at school and sanitized at the end of each day.
- Sleep sack
- Premixed and pre-measured bottles
- Any snacks or food if your child is not eating from the PBS school menu. Food may not be sent to school in glass jars/containers.
- Disposable Diapers (Individual diapers do NOT have to be labeled)
- 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes each month (Do not label)

Toddler Supply List

- 2 containers of Clorox/Lysol wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packs of 8-count Crayola Jumbo Crayons
- 5-pack of Play-Doh
- Disposable Diapers/pull-ups
- 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes each month

Twos Supply List

- 2 containers of Clorox/Lysol wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packs of 8-count Crayola Jumbo Crayons
- 5-pack of Play-Doh
- Diapers/pull-ups (if applicable)
- 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes each month

PK3 Supply List

- Small Backpack (sent daily)
- Refillable spill-proof water bottle (sent daily)
- 2 packs of 8-count Crayola Jumbo Crayons
- 10 Elmer's Disappearing Purple Glue Sticks
- 1 pair of blunt-tip Fiskars scissors (*No plastic blades*)
- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 containers of Clorox/Lysol wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 5-pack of Play-Doh
- Girls: 1 Box Quart-size Ziploc bags
- Boys: 1 Box Gallon-size Ziploc bags
- 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes in August and again in January

PK4 Supply List

- Backpack (sent daily)
- Refillable spill-proof water bottle (sent daily)
- 2 packs of 24-count Crayola Crayons
- 10-pack of Crayola Classic Markers
- 1 pair of blunt-tip Fiskars scissors (*No plastic blades*)
- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 containers of Clorox/Lysol wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 5-pack of Play-Doh
- Girls: Box of Quart-size Ziploc bags
- Boys: Box of Gallon-size Ziploc bags
- 4 large packs of unscented/sensitive skin wipes in August and again in January
