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- Student must earn 3 service hours per semester
 - Forms/Hours will be due the week before Mid-term Exams and the week before Final Exams (the specific dates will be assigned in class)- The form must be fully completed for credit
 - Student may serve for 3 hours at one time, or as many times as needed to total 3 hours-student may choose different service experiences (for example, the student may serve one Sunday at church, and one Saturday at an assisted living center, or the student may serve multiple Sundays at church)
 - Student is responsible for scheduling his/her own service opportunities.
 - Student is required to write a paragraph about serving. If the student served more than once during the semester, he/she may choose one service experience to write about. The student does not have to write a paragraph about each experience.
 - Service hours are defined as: serving outside of school hours, for someone less fortunate than yourself, without receiving anything in return- since serving our families is a part of being a family, service hours must be earned by serving someone other than a family member.
 - Please contact Mr. or Mrs. White to verify approval of a service opportunity before the student serves.
 - Opportunities will be mentioned in class regularly. Please email Mr. or Mrs. White with any service opportunities you know of in your church or community throughout the year.
 - Suggestions for serving are: Visiting an assisted living facility, volunteering at the Food Bank, serving in the Nursery/Children's service at church, Community outreaches, Assisting local charities
